## Who are we?

Glen Oroua School is a decile 9 primary school for years 0-8. Established in 1903, the school is situated in Glen Oroua at the southern end of Sansons Road.

## What do we provide?

We are a multi-room school providing good student-teacher ratios in three classes.

- Juniors — Rm 3
- Middle — Rm 2
- Seniors — Rm 1



Learning support is provided for those with identified needs.

Our Principal is released from the classroom from morning tea onwards and provides 1—1 or small group support where needed.

Our teachers are all qualified and registered, and are motivated to help our students achieve excellence.



## What facilities are available to students?

Facilities include:

- Well maintained classrooms.
- An extensive library in a dedicated building.
- A swimming pool (with a cover), which is also available for after-hours community use during summer.
- 2 purpose built playgrounds, as well as a flying fox, maypole and trampoline.
- Extensive grounds, including a native area with a boardwalk, playing fields and a hedge in which the students may play.
- A vegetable garden for each classroom.
- Computers in all classrooms, as well as mini iPads in the junior and middle rooms and Chromebooks in the senior room, which are integrated into the curriculum.
- Break-out/technology area adjacent to our brand new administration block.
