Thank you to everyone who has registered their animals for our Lamb and Calf Day.

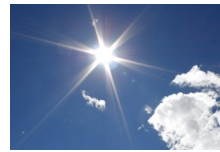


Those of you with calves will need to use this number **12665358** to transfer your calf **TO & FROM** (this is the key) the event. Please make sure this is done!



The NAIT number for Championship day at Rongotea is **12662197**.

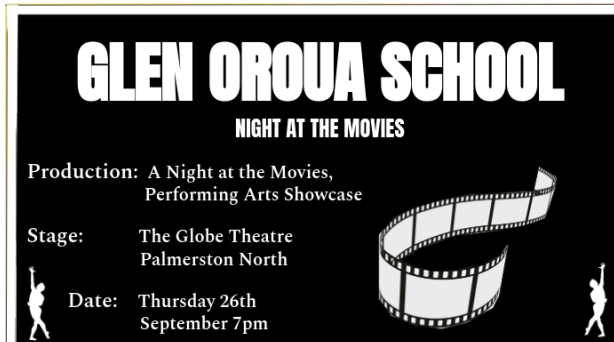

SUMMER HOCKEY

Registrations are open for summer hockey held at the turfs in Palmerston North in term 4.

Year 1&2 play 4-aside on 1/6 turf, Year 3&4, 5&6 and 7&8 teams play 6-aside on 1/3 turf, all 25 minute games.

The season goes for 6 weeks from 22nd October to 28th November (weeks 2-7 of term 4) with Year 1&2 and 3&4 playing on Tuesday afternoons, Year 5&6 on Wednesday afternoons, and Year 7&8 on Thursday afternoons, all teams' draws are between 3.30 - 6pm.
