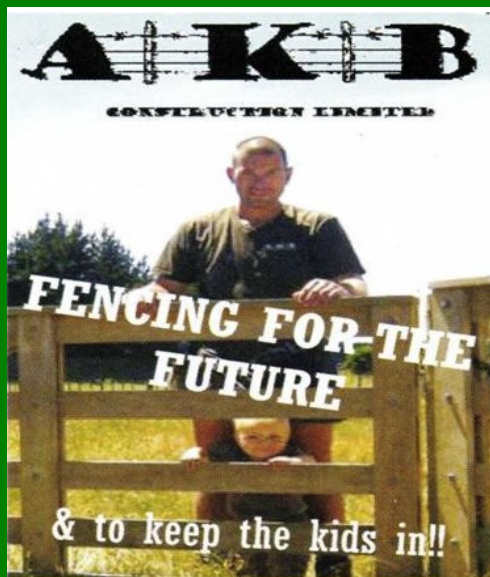

Paid Union Meetings - Glen Oroua School teachers who are members of NZEI Te Riu Roa will be attending a paid union meeting on Friday 2 July, with some attending in the morning and others in the afternoon. The purpose of these meetings is for teachers to discuss the priorities for the renegotiation of their collective agreement in 2022. Issues being discussed, such as school staffing levels, directly impact on the education of your children. These meetings are a critical component of the negotiation process and it is the legal right of all members to attend a meeting and have their say. We are in the fortunate position of having our awesome release teacher, Kate Saunders, available to teach in these classes, and the school will remain open.

Generation Online Parent Session - Next week, on Monday and Tuesday, we have Generation Online visiting our school. Generation Online provide support and education around digital and cyber-safety and will be working with our school board, staff and students to provide support around creating programmes and processes to promote the safe use of online spaces.
