

Tēnā koutou Glen Oroua families,

Last term our Year 4-8 students completed a Well-being Survey created by NZCER (NZ Council for Educational Research) to gain the children's opinions about how they feel about school. They were asked questions around how/if they experience caring, respectful and welcoming interactions at school.

Some of the heartening results were around students perception that teachers thought all students could do well at school, that teachers would take action if students were hit or bullied, and every child that completed the survey agreed that their parents and their teachers respect each other. Great, isn't it?

Some areas for development were around a number of students not feeling they could stand up for themselves or others, or ask other students for help, or explain how they are feeling if they need to.

These are skills that we would like our students to be able to develop. Pleasingly, there are some great programmes about that we are looking into that can specifically target the areas of need that popped up from the Wellbeing Survey.

The first is the Pause, Breathe, Smile mindfulness and wellbeing training that our teaching and support staff have begun working with, and is the purpose of our Teacher Only Day on September 17th later on in the term.

We will let you know about the plans for other programmes, we are currently researching, once we have firmed them up.
