Papatūanuku...

Our overarching topic across the school for the second half of 2023 is Papatūanuku. Students will be involved in experiences that develop understandings around the habitats and the produce the land provides and how we need to protect that. They will plant for our summer vegetable gardens. They will learn the pūrakau/story of Ranginui and Paptūanuku, and about respecting different perspectives. Students will create artworks along these lines which will be the theme of our Art Exhibition on Friday 15 September. This learning will run alongside our continued focus on literacy and mathematics.

Bus Safety...
