This project of the Glen Oroua-Taikorea Community Committee is now well underway, creating a safer pathway that is off the road between the Glen Oroua Hall & School.


In time, students will be able to use this when coming to and from school (and so avoiding that tricky corner), and for the GO Playgroup and our school to have easier access between the two spaces during the day.


