








## Extension to Māhuri

The first phase of this is nearly complete, and the room is looking great, alongside providing a great breakout space for our Māhuri students. We are naming the new room 'Ngahere' which continues on the metaphor of our classroom names: Kākano - Seed, Tupu - Seedling, Māhuri - Sapling, & Rākau - Tree. The Ngahere (forest) is a place where all the different types of trees & plants are together - which will be the same for our people in our meeting and hui-ā-kura/assembly room - Ngahere.

Our next steps for this area is to have doors installed between the two spaces, and a mural painted on the beautiful blank canvas that is the car park facing wall, and we are aiming to have both of these completed before the end of this term. Our Friends of the School are funding this artwork, and we are looking to collaborate with an artist that has connections with some of our students.
